Students With Dependents

The Students with Dependent Children (SWD) Grant increases the Cal Grant award by up to \$6,000 for qualifying Cal Grant A and B recipients and up to \$4,000 for qualifying Cal Grant C recipients.

To qualify, students must have dependent children that are under 18 years of age for whom they provide more than half of their financial support during the academic year.
