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## ***Learning Outcomes Statement***

Students successfully completing a course in this area will be able to identify and evaluate the historical and cultural context of the human experience as it relates to their perspective of that experience.

## ***Means of Assessment (Measurement Method)***

Students were assessed during the Fall 2023 semester. Assessments occurred in 8 sections in the following courses and resulted in a total of 137 assessments.

- ASL-101, 102, and 103

## ***Summary of Evidence***

Referring to Table 1, there was no disproportionate impact among ethnicity or gender. The Faculty Department Chairs reviewed the results of the assessments at the March 1, 2024 meeting.
