- Reviews workplace inspections to identify themes and recommends methods for eliminating or controlling hazards.
- Reviews the college's schedule to update and revise workplace safety and health programs; and makes suggestions to management for safety-related improvements.
- Reviews and provides input on safety-related facility plans and projects.
