**Rationale:** This course is fundamental to health coverage as it directly applies to women. Students begin to explore communities by examining cultural norms and gender roles. They will culminate their learning by contrasting the cultural norms to present the foundations upon which members of a society differentiate and identify themselves. Students will demonstrate their understanding of concepts related to women's health disparities, including categories such as class, gender, religion, ethnicity, and race, which are formed around variations in cultural feminist symbols, social norms, beliefs, and cultural structures.

o. Course Subject/Number: (<u>Mathematics 250E</u>)

Title: Single Variable Calculus I Enhanced Rationale:

- 1. AB1705 requires that registered STEM students who have an overall GPA < 2.6 or have not passed Trigonometry, Precalculus, or Calculus with a C or better, must be placed into a STEM Calculus I course with no more than 2 additional units of support.
- 2. MATH 250 is the first of a series of three calculus courses, required for degrees in mathematics and many of the sciences.
- 3. MATH 250 satisfies the associate degree general education requirement for computation and analytical thinking.
- 4. MATH 250 satisfies the IGETC requirement for mathematical concepts and quantitative reasoning and the CSU general education requirement for mathematics.
- 5. MATH 250 is transferable to both CSU and UC.
